

2017 Snipe Fleet 210 Championship Series Notice of Race & Sailing Instructions

The 2017 Rocky Mountain Snipe Fleet Championship Series will take place April 1, 2017 though October 31, 2017.

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:

The Rocky Mountain Snipe Fleet 210 in co-operation with the Snipe Class International Racing Association-USA and Union Sailing Club at Union Reservoir, Longmont, CO.

RULES:

The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing and Prescriptions, Union Sailing Club Rules and Regulations and Club Sailing Instructions.

ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY:

This series is open to Snipe Class boats and skippers who are not affiliated with another Snipe Class Fleet and are sanctioned for the series by the Fleet 210 Fleet Captain. Union Reservoir Daily Park or Season Pass is REQUIRED.

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS:

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the Union Sailing Club's shed and/ or distributed via email to the members.

SCHEDULE:

- All races in the Union Sailing Club Sunday Series Races are eligible for this series. Only races with 3 or more starting Snipes will be scored for this series.
- No races of any official regatta with it's own trophies will be included.
- Additional races with 3 or more Snipes participating can be included in this series with the approval of the Fleet 210 Fleet Captain.
- 5 scored races will constitute the series.

SCORING:

Snipe finishing sequence will be extracted from the official USC Sunday Series Results.

The CHIPS 3 High Point System will be used to score the Series. The following changes apply.

- A boat's worst score will be excluded from her total for every 5 races completed in the Series.
- RC: Skippers serving on Race Committee staff will be scored for each race their average place of the races they have sailed in the series.
- RTC: Representing the Club: A sailor who misses Club races because they are
 participating in another Snipe sailing event and register for that event as a
 member of Union Sailing Club may notify the Race Committee Chair and be
 scored their average place of the races they have sailed in the series for the
 races missed.
- TLE: A Skipper scored TLE will be scored the number of finishers plus 1 place.
- DNS, OCS, DNF and RET: shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats that came to the starting area in the Fleet. DNC and DSQ shall be scored zero points.
